will weaken law enforcement, open the door for organized crime, exploit Missouri families, and protect casinos from competition in the future.

According to a report submitted to the Joint Committee on Education by the Missouri Senate Minority Caucus on May 12, **half** of Missouri schools will not receive any money at all and an unbelievable 81% of the money collected will not be distributed.

Both candidates for governor, Kenny Hulshof and Jay Nixon, the St. Louis Post Dispatch, Kansas City Tribune and Joplin globe agree that Prop A is not good for Missourians. Even the Missouri teachers' unions refuse to endorse Prop A.
